### NOTIFICATION NO.22/2025

#### **KGCE Engineering I & II Year Regular & Supplementary (Rev 22) - II Year Supplementary (Rev 2003) Exam April 2025**

1. The Kerala Government Certificate Examination in Engineering (Rev22 and Rev2003) will be conducted during the month of June 2025 by the Controller of Technical Examinations, Thiruvananthapuram.
2. Centers for Theory and Practical Examinations will be announced later on and no request for change of examination centres allotted shall be entertained.

#### **Minimum qualification and rules for appearing the Examination**

3. The minimum qualification for admission to the Examination is S.S.L.C (Passed) or equivalent and candidate must have completed the prescribed course of study in the branches concerned, for two years in Engineering Institution duly recognized by the Government and securing not less than 75% attendance. Candidates should have obtained Permanent Register Number (PRN) from the Controller of Technical Examinations (CTE).
4. The failed candidates need to appear only for failed subjects on the subsequent sitting.
5. Candidates will not be allowed to register for the Examination in piecemeal. They shall register all the subjects in which they have to pass.
6. A candidate will be allowed to appear for the Examination only for a maximum of four chances within the validity of registration time. **They will have to pass the**

**whole Examination within four consecutive chances offered by the CTE.**

7. Application for Registration need be made online in the portal **www.sbte.kerala.gov.in..** Candidates can register for the examination through their login.

8. Regular candidates who have updated their profile in the portal can make the examination registration through their login.

9. All entries in the registration window need be carefully filled in and the registration process will be completed with the online submission of the form and the payment of fees required (As applicable).

10. Candidates are required to keep the reference id of the registration. There is no need to submit the print out of the application to the institution or to the Office of the Controller of Technical Examination.

**Note :** The **Rev2003** Supplementary exam can be attended only by the candidates who had taken admission to **KGCE** Course in the **Year 2020** and onwards.

**11. Fees for the Examination is as follows**

- For Regular Examination: - **Rs. 660/-**
- In addition to examination fee as mentioned above, **Practical Examinations fees of Rs.170/- per paper** is to be paid to the chief superintendent of examination centre before appearing for the practical examination.
- For **Revision 2022** candidates, **Project Evaluation fees of Rs.170/- per paper** (in addition to practical examination fee) is to be paid to the practical examination center.
- For Supplementary Examination:- **Rs.170/- per paper**

**12.** The fee for the examination shall be remitted through online mode along with the registration. Payment through other modes will not be accepted.

**13.** Remittance of fee will not be a claim for writing the examination. Only candidates who satisfy the conditions of eligibility shall be treated as bonafide candidates.

**14.** Amount of examination fees once remitted will not be refunded or adjusted towards fees for subsequent examination on any account.

**15.** The fee concession status of candidates eligible for Fee concession (SC / ST / OEC candidates, for whom fee concession is approved by the SC development department) shall be updated by the Principals of the institutions. It shall be the responsibility of the institutions concerned to remit the fee to the Controller of Technical Examinations.

**16.** Extra time up to 20 minutes per hour for the scheduled duration of each theory paper for all papers of the examination is sanctioned to differently abled candidates with 40% or above disability as per GO(MS) No.601/2021/H.Edn dated 17.04.2021. Such candidates should obtain permission from the Director of Technical Education in this regard.

**17.** Malpractice:-Malpractice in any form during the examination is not permitted. Candidates indulging in malpractices are liable to undergo punishment as contained in G.O (Rt) No. 1077/2020/HEdn dated Thiruvananthapuram, 24.08.2020.

**18.** Candidates should use only blue or black ink for written examinations.

**19.** Time Table for the examination will be published in the SBTE portal [www.sbte.kerala.gov.in](http://www.sbte.kerala.gov.in).

**20. Publication of Results:**

The result of the examination will be published in [www.sbte.kerala.gov.in](http://www.sbte.kerala.gov.in).

**21. Finalisation of Results:**

The results of the examination shall be finalized on the day of completion of 4 months from the publication of results. No change in the examination results shall be permitted after the finalization of results / printing of original certificate or Mark list of the candidate whichever is earlier.

The claims for Grace marks are expected to be submitted well in advance to the publication of results and in any case not later than 3 months from the date of publication of results.

**22. Issue of Mark list / Certificate:**

The issue of Mark lists / Certificates shall be as per G.O (Rt) No. 1077/2020/H.Edn dated Thiruvananthapuram, 24.08.2020.

Successful candidates shall be issued Mark list / Certificates by the Controller of Technical Examinations.

Original Certificates / Mark lists shall be issued on the Online request of the candidate and the same shall be sent to the address of the candidate in India in Speed post. Required fee need be remitted Online for the same. Results shall be finalized on the issue of the Original certificate / Mark list and no change shall be entertained later.
