INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. The candidate should appear for the examination as per the published timetable.
2. The candidate should produce Government issued photo identity card (Aadhar Card, Voters ID, Driving License, Passport.) along with the hall-ticket to the invigilator in each session of the examination. Candidates without a valid ID proof shall not be permitted to attend the examinations under any circumstances.
3. The hall-ticket downloaded from SBTE website shall bear the latest photograph of the candidate with signature.
4. Candidate should occupy the seats 15 minutes before the scheduled time for the commencement of examination.
5. Candidate should submit his/her signature, thumb impression, name of ID proof and ID number in the respective student verification statements.
6. Candidates are prohibited from leaving the hall before the final bell and properly handing over the answer book and the detached data part.
7. Candidates should use black ball point pen for filling the OMR facing sheet.
8. The candidate will be not be allowed to write the examination without the valid Hall Ticket.
9. Malpractice in any form is prohibited. Disciplinary action shall be initiated against those involved in malpractice as per the existing rules.
10. Strict silence shall be maintained in the examination hall.
11. Exchange of materials of any kind is prohibited in the examination hall.
12. Candidates are prohibited from bringing any kind of electronic gadgets including mobile phones, tablets, electronic watches etc.
13. Candidates shall not write their register number in any place other than the location marked in the OMR answer book. Putting any identification mark in any part of the answer book will be treated as malpractice.
